n drums vocals. harmonica, keyboard, and sax, Tim Pfeifer has spent most of his long year career as an entertainer-musician with his brother, Anthony. (The result of their work together is a very well oiled rhythm section.) Tim appeared twice on the national television show Star Search as a member of The Heat and played drums on production work with the movie company Paramount Pictures. He won the Best Drummer award in a 4 state battle of the band's contest.

n guitar, vocals, and keyboard, Anthony Pfeifer has to his credit several decades of experience as a serious entertainer-musician. He won the Best Vocalist award in a 4 state battle of the band's contest. As a member of BMI, his original material is published with companies in Nashville, Phoenix, Los Angeles and Kansas City. He has done soundtrack work for the movie company Paramount Pictures. and as a member of The Heat. appeared twice on the national television show Star Search.

n bass guitar and backing vocals, Ray Schmidtberger is another seasoned veteran in the music business with several decades to his credit. Ray has spent most of his years performing with the ever popular Jimmy Dee and the Fabulous Destinations Band. In fact, Ray was one of the early members of Jimmy Dee along with Tim and Anthony. Ray plays a very important part in this trio, holding down a solid bass line and excellent backing vocals.
